Our Lady of the Lakes Cemetery Regulations

- 1. Artificial flowers that are improperly placed or unattached upon any portion of the cemetery grounds will be removed & disposed of by cemetery personnel. **Safety regulation**-sharp objects can be picked up by mower blades and hurled through air and strike personnel or visitors to the grounds.
- 2. For the same reason crushed stone, wood chips, and shells on graves are strictly prohibited. They will be removed & disposed of by cemetery personnel.
- 3. Fresh flowers may be placed on graves in metal vases only. Potted plants should not exceed 12" in diameter. WARNING NO glass containers. This is a serious safety hazard to everyone. ***
- 4. No shrubs, bushes, trees or perennial flowers may be planted on the graves or any where in the cemetery. ***
- 5. Wooden, wire or trellis, fences or stands for flowers are NOT permitted on graves or any where in the cemetery. ***
- 6. Monuments and foot stones must be purchased through a monument company and adhere to cemetery's specifications. There is to be no rocks or hand made monuments. *** All monument foundations will be installed by cemetery personnel.
- 7. It is your responsibility to remove any decorations that have become withered and unsightly.
- 8. Please place trash in the receptacles provided.

*** The Cemetery reserves the right to remove any items that do not adhere to these regulations.
